
Applications are now open for the largest prize-winning technology competitions in Türkiye's history, organized within the scope of TEKNOFEST, which aims to raise awareness about technology and science throughout the society and increase Türkiye's human resources trained in science and engineering!

In order to be a part of TEKNOFEST Aerospace and Technology Festival, you can apply to the competition in the field you are interested in by following the application steps below.

TEKNOFEST 2026 TECHNOLOGY COMPETITIONS APPLICATION GUIDE

t3kys.com Corporate Management System is used for TEKNOFEST competition applications. All processes and document submissions, including the application phase of the competition, are carried out using this platform. In this direction, in order to participate in the TEKNOFEST Competition you want to participate in, you must first create an application via T3 CMS. The application steps are given below.

*To apply for any of the TEKNOFEST competitions through CMS, you must first have a profile. If you already have a profile on CMS, you can access the login page via the link www.t3kys.com. There are two options for logging in: **Login with Email** and **Login with Phone Number**. You can log in by selecting either of these options.*

Afterwards, you can log in from the “Log In” screen using the information you provided during registration.



UPDATE YOUR PROFILE!

After clicking the “Apply” button located above the competition category you have selected, the “Update Profile” step appears. At this stage, the applicant is expected to review the personal information registered in the system and update any missing or incorrect details. Profile information is taken as the basis during the application evaluation process, official correspondence, and team-related procedures.

SELECT A TEAM!

Before applying to the TEKNOFEST Technology Competitions, each participant is required to create a team individual applications are not accepted. Even if you may need to update team members later, you can create your team first and then proceed with your application. The right to make team-specific updates will continue for a period determined by TEKNOFEST even after applications are completed. You can follow the steps below to create a team.

After updating the profile information, the process continues to the “Teams” section. This screen is the step where you select the team with which you will apply for the competition. In the form, you can either choose a team you have previously created or create a new team.

You can activate your inactive teams by clicking the “Copy and continue” option. If a user needs to create a new team-either because no team has been created before or because they do not wish to use any of the existing teams-they can proceed with the application by clicking the “New Team” button located in the upper right corner of the screen.



CREATE/EDIT
THE TEAM!

When the user clicks the “Select” button in the row of the team they wish to apply with from the list, the system automatically redirects them to the “Edit Team” screen. On this screen, the details of the selected team are displayed, and the user can make the necessary updates to fields such as the team name, team type, and team description. This option is suitable for users who want to continue the application process with a previously created team.

When the “New Team” button is clicked, the user is directly redirected to the “Edit Team” stage. On this screen, the user is expected to enter the basic information required for the new team, including the team name, team structure, and the initial details needed for members to be added in the following steps. The option to create a new team is generally preferred by first-time applicants or users who wish to establish a separate team for each competition.

Create/Edit Team

1. Team Information

Enter general information about your team. This field includes your team's structure, number of participants and introduction.

Team Name *
Team name must be 3-50 characters. Only letters, numbers, hyphens (-), and underscores (_) are allowed. Cannot consist of only numbers or have leading/trailing spaces.

Team Founded Year *
The team's founding year cannot be a date later than the current year.

In both cases whether an existing team is selected or a new team is created the application process continues through the editing and completion of the team information. Therefore, selecting or creating a team is a critical stage to ensure that the application proceeds smoothly.

There are some important points you should pay attention to at this stage:

The **Team Type** is used to confirm whether your team is affiliated with any institution or school. In the team type selection, **Institution** refers to applications made on behalf of an institution, organization, or private entity, while **Graduate – Institution** indicates that graduated individuals are participating in the competition representing an institution. The **Graduate – School** option is used when team members have graduated but are applying on behalf of the last educational institution they attended, whereas the **School** option applies to cases in which team members are currently students and are participating in the competition representing their school.

The remaining information should be completed as requested. If the option you wish to select in multiple-choice questions is not available, or if you experience any issues during the process, you may contact us by sending a brief explanatory email to iletisim@teknofest.org.

After all required fields have been completed, you can create your team by clicking the **“Save and Continue”** button. Once the team registration process is completed, please ensure that you have received a confirmation email indicating that your team has been successfully created and that the team is visible on your team page.

2. Team Type and Education Information

Team Type *
Select the appropriate option based on your team's structure (school team, company team, etc.)

3. Team Location Information

Enter location information about your team. Location information of team members.

Country the Team Participated in *
You can choose the country where team members (except the advisor) participate the most, or you can make your selection based on the country you wish to represent.

City Where Team Participated *
You can choose the city where most team members (excluding the advisor) are located, or you can make your selection based on the city you wish to represent.

District Where the Team Participated *
You can choose the district where team members (excluding the advisor) participate the most, or you can make your selection based on the district you wish to represent.

4. Team Introduction Information

Enter introductory information about your team. Introductory information about team members.

Please share introductory information reflecting your team's purpose, areas of work, and team members' experience in this field. Forming a team is not the same as applying; the team introduction document is only required for team information.



TEAM OPERATIONS!

After creating a team, the “Team Operations” section appears.

To update the members of a team you have previously created, click the “Add Member” button located under the relevant team on the Team Members screen. In the “Invite” section on the Team Members screen, you can invite members who have already registered and created a profile on CMS by entering their **Turkish ID Number or Passport Number, Email Address, and Member Role**. (Please make sure that the relevant member’s Turkish ID / Passport Number and Email Address are registered in CMS.)

Advisors must add themselves to the team with the advisor role.






After the application is completed, the “Your Application Has Been Received” page opens. You can view your Team ID and Application ID on the relevant page.
