

## **NECMETTIN ERBAKAN UNIVERSITY 2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION, APPLICATION, PREFERENCE, AND PLACEMENT GUIDE**

The application and admission procedures for international students seeking admission to the associate degree and undergraduate programmes at Necmettin Erbakan University for the 2026–2027 academic year are conducted in accordance with Article 45/f of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, as amended by Act No. 6287, the Principles Regarding the Admission of International Students established by the Higher Education Council, and the provisions of our University's International Student Admission Directive.

### ***1. Applicants:***

#### **a) Applicants must be in their final year of high school or have graduated;**

*1)* Foreign nationals (provided they have not attended or graduated from secondary schools (high schools) in Türkiye [excluding foreign nationals who have completed their entire secondary education at embassy schools or international private educational institutions listed in the MOBIS system, as well as foreign nationals who have come to our country under projects run by the Ministry of National Education or the Higher Education Council])

*2)* Those who were Turkish citizens by birth but renounced their Turkish citizenship with the permission from the Ministry of the Interior, and those who can provide proof that they hold a Blue Card issued to persons who have lost their Turkish citizenship upon request (provided that they have not attended or graduated from secondary schools (high schools) in Türkiye or the TRNC) (Candidates applying for international students are advised to review Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901.)

*3)* Those who have acquired Turkish citizenship through naturalisation whilst retaining their foreign nationality / dual nationals in this situation (provided that they have not attended or graduated from secondary education institutions in Türkiye or the TRNC)

*4)* Turkish nationals who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country, excluding the TRNC (including those who have completed their entire secondary education [high school] at Turkish schools established under the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC)

*5)* Those who are citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (provided they have not attended or graduated from secondary education institutions in Türkiye or from secondary schools in the TRNC that follow the Turkish curriculum) and who meet the criteria set out in the application and admission guidelines approved by the Higher Education Council for higher education institutions, or who hold GCE A-Levels or TR-YÖS qualifications,

will be accepted,

#### **b) Applicants whose applications will not be accepted:**

*1)* Turkish nationals who have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Türkiye or the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus,

2) Those who are citizens of the TRNC / dual nationals who hold TRNC citizenship (who have completed their entire secondary education (secondary school) in TRNC secondary schools and hold or will hold GCE A-Level results, or TRNC nationals who have completed their entire secondary education (secondary school) in a foreign country, except for those who meet the criteria specified in the application and admission guidelines approved by the Higher Education Council for TR-YÖS or higher education institutions),

3) Dual nationals whose first nationality by birth is Turkish citizenship, as defined in Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 (except those who meet the conditions set out in subparagraph 4 of paragraph (a)),

4) Turkish nationals or dual nationals whose first nationality by birth is Turkish, as defined in Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, who are studying at schools attached to embassies in Türkiye or at foreign secondary schools in Türkiye,

5) a) TRNC citizens and those who have renounced Turkish citizenship or hold a Blue Card who are currently studying at or have graduated from secondary schools (high schools) in Türkiye and the TRNC,

b) Foreign nationals currently studying at or who have graduated from secondary schools (high schools) in Türkiye (excluding foreign nationals who have completed their entire secondary education at embassy schools or international private educational institutions listed in the MOBİS system, as well as foreign nationals who have come to our country under projects run by the Ministry of National Education or the Council of Higher Education),

## **3. Documents Required for Online Applications:**

3.1. High school diploma and its Turkish translation,

3.2. TR-YÖS Results Certificate, if available,

**3.3.** A Turkish translation of the academic transcript to be obtained from their institution by students who are in the process of graduating at the time of application,

**3.4.** An official academic transcript, certified by the school principal, showing the subjects studied, marks achieved and grade point average during secondary school, together with a Turkish translation. (Applications submitted with documents that do not include grading scales or letter grades, or that cannot be converted to a 100-point scale, will not be considered.)

**3.5.** The Blue Card held by candidates who were Turkish citizens by birth but have lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce it, or the certificate of permission to renounce Turkish citizenship issued by the Ministry of the Interior,

**3.6.** For applications submitted by candidates with dual nationality, a certified copy of the full civil registry record,

**3.7.** Passport or identity document,

**3.8.** One (1) photograph,

**3.9.** Turkish citizens who have completed their secondary education (excluding the TRNC) abroad, and students with dual nationality where one of which is Turkish, must provide an entry-exit record confirming their presence in the country where they studied throughout their period of study (this can be obtained via e-Government, from Police Headquarters, or by applying to our diplomatic missions).

**3.10.** For applicants applying with a secondary school leaving certificate whose diploma or transcript does not include their final grade point average, a Turkish translation of a document issued by their school showing their final grade point average required.

#### ***4. Application, Assessment and Placement Dates:***

International student admissions and application process	June 15 – July 3, 2026
Placement results	July 24, 2026

- The date on which the placement results are announced may vary depending on the volume of applications.
- The registration period and the supplementary placement schedule will be announced alongside the placement results.

#### ***5. Application and Preference Procedures:***

**5.1.** Applications must be submitted online.

**5.2.** Candidates are required to register with the system using their personal details and email address, and to ensure that the information they provide is complete and accurate. Applications from candidates who provide incomplete or incorrect information or documents will not be accepted.

**5.3.** Applicants may select a maximum of five (5) programmes from those listed in the quota table.

5.4. The placement of any candidate found, after the application process, to have provided information or documents that are found to be false will be cancelled.

## 6. Assessment and Placement Procedures:

6.1. Candidates' placement scores are calculated using the following criteria.

6.1.1. The equivalent of the exam/diploma scores of candidates applying with their TR-YÖS results, a graduation certificate from a secondary school affiliated with the Maarif Foundation, or a graduation certificate from a secondary school in a European country, on a 100-point scale,

6.1.2. Candidates with TRNC nationality applying with GCE AL examination results, as well as those from secondary schools in Türkiye (including Embassy schools, international private educational institutions listed in the MOBIS system, and foreign nationals coming to our country under projects run by the Ministry of National Education or the Higher Education Council) shall have their diploma scores converted to 90% of the equivalent in the 100-point system,

6.1.3. 70% of the equivalent of the diploma scores of candidates who have graduated from other secondary schools on the 100-point scale,

6.1.4. When converting achievement scores assessed under different grading systems to a 100-point scale, the score is calculated by multiplying the mark obtained by 100 and dividing it by the maximum score of the relevant grading system.

General formula:

$$Y=(N \times 100) / M$$

In this case:

Y = equivalent to a 100-point scale

N = The mark obtained by the candidate

M = The maximum score in the grading system

6.1.5. The marks of candidates applying with ABITUR and MATURA qualifications will first be converted to a 4-point scale in accordance with the table below, and then to a 100-point scale using the method specified in section 6.1.4.

**6.1.6.** “When assessing GCE AL examination results, the following marks are used: A\*=100, A=90, B=80, C=70, D=60 and E=50. The candidate’s final mark is calculated as the arithmetic mean of the converted subject marks.”

**6.2.** The placement process is carried out by taking into account the candidates’ order of preference, starting with the highest score.

**6.3.** If candidates who have chosen the same programme have the same score, priority will be given to the candidate who listed that programme as a higher preference; if the scores remain equal, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

**6.4.** Candidates will be placed on only one programme from among their choices.

**6.5.** Applications from candidates found to have submitted more than one application will be cancelled.

### **7. *Announcement of Results:***

**7.1.** Applicants can view the results of their programme placements on our University’s website or by logging into the application system.

**7.2.** Successful applicants can access their acceptance letters by logging into the application system once the results have been announced.

### **8. *Registration Procedures:***

**8.1.** Registration takes place on the dates announced by the academic units (Faculty/Conservatoire/Vocational School).

**8.2.** The documents required for registration, together with the results, are published on our University’s website.
